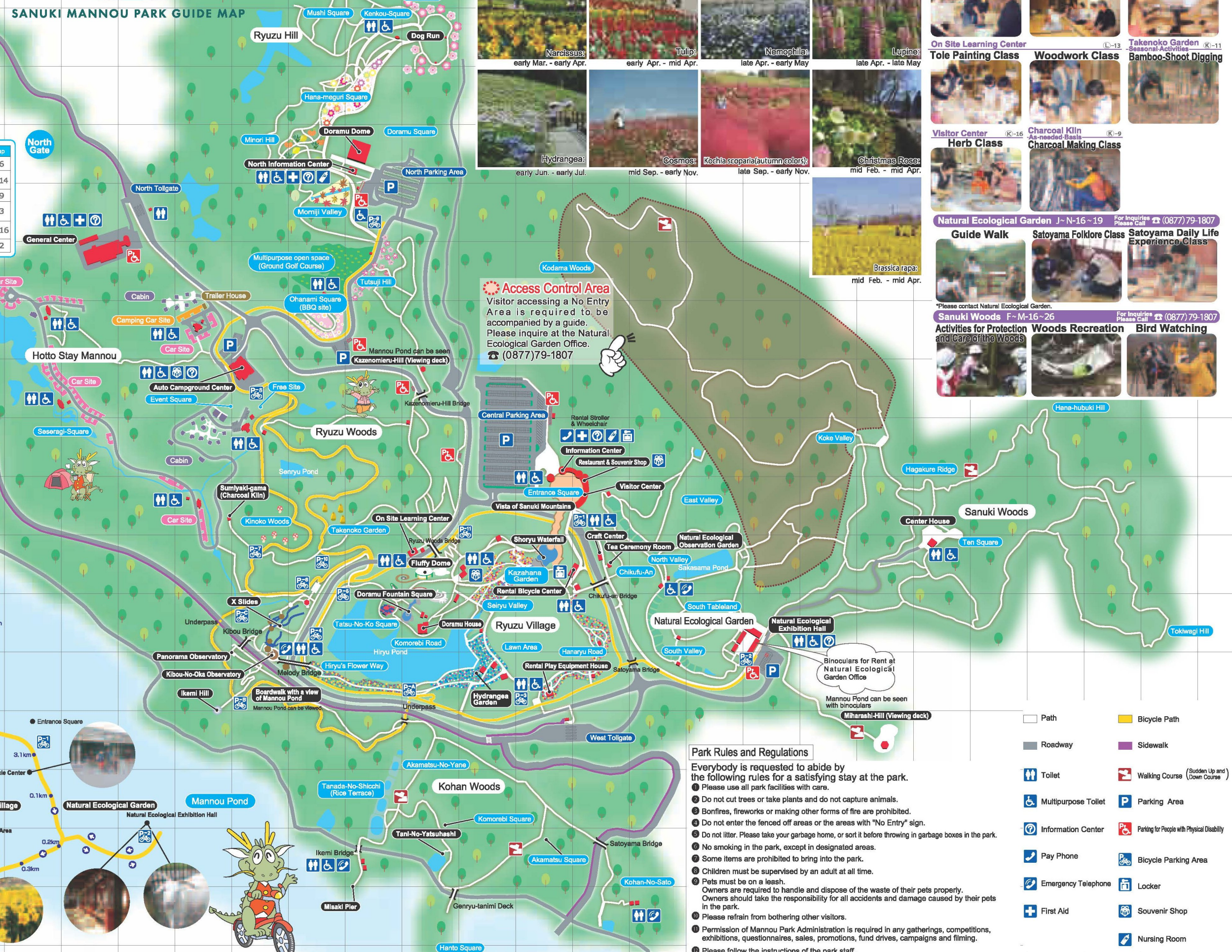
Various kinds of birds can be seen. Enjoy bird watching!

Bicycle Path

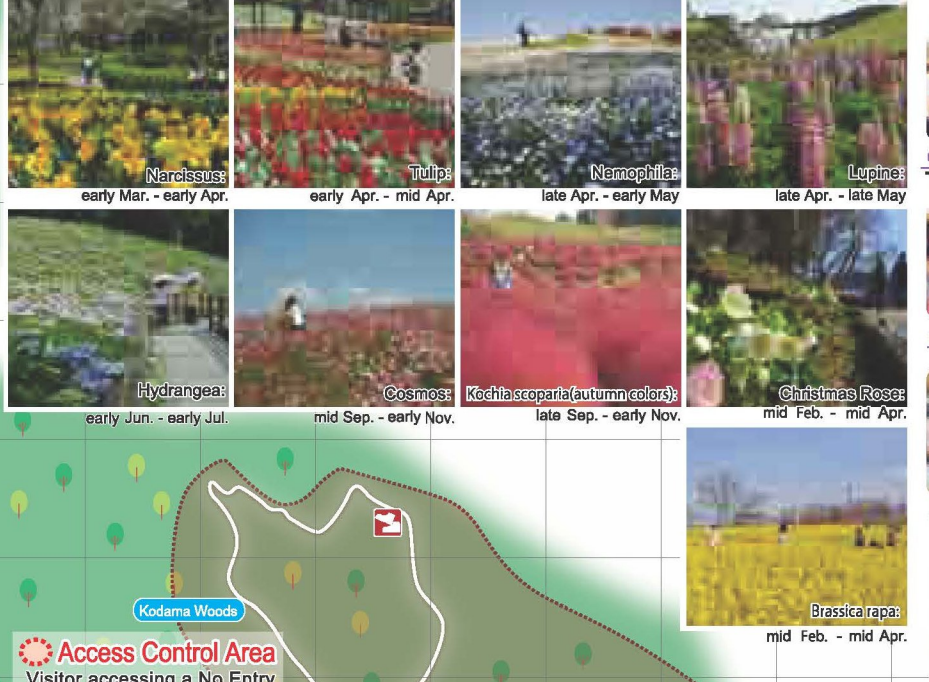
Run through 5.88 km long lush greeneries!

One is a loop course, going on the periphery of Lawn Area, Auto Campground, Ryuzu Woods and Ryuzu Hills. The other is a back and forth course to Natural Ecological Garden. Total length is 5.88 km.

- Park Rules and Regulations**
- Everybody is requested to abide by the following rules for a satisfying stay at the park.
- Please use all park facilities with care.
 - Do not cut trees or take plants and do not capture animals.
 - Bonfires, fireworks or making other forms of fire are prohibited.
 - Do not enter the fenced off areas or the areas with "No Entry" sign.
 - Do not litter. Please take your garbage home, or sort it before throwing in garbage boxes in the park.
 - No smoking in the park, except in designated areas.
 - Some items are prohibited to bring into the park.
 - Children must be supervised by an adult at all time.
 - Pets must be on a leash. Owners are required to handle and dispose of the waste of their pets properly. Owners should take the responsibility for all accidents and damage caused by their pets in the park.
 - Please refrain from bothering other visitors.
 - Permission of Mannou Park Administration is required in any gatherings, competitions, exhibitions, questionnaires, sales, promotions, fund drives, campaigns and filming.
 - Please follow the instructions of the park staff.
