

# Let's touch it! Play with Gagaku (Japanese traditional music and dance)

Gagaku is music which is used for wedding ceremonies, etc., conducted at Shinto shrines. You can play traditional musical instruments handed over from the Heian Period. The musical instrument called Sho describes the light from heaven. "Hichiriki" describes earth (the human voice). "Ryuteki" describes scenes where dragons travel between heaven and earth. It is a unique opportunity where you can experience Gagaku which recently attracts attention as therapeutic music. Slip back in time to eternal history by listening to live music, playing musical instruments on your own or wearing white clothes or costumes for players. Let's be a "Gagaku girl" or "Gagaku boy"!
